

Head Diving Coach Job Description

Team New York Aquatics (TNYA) is searching for a Certified USA Diving Competition Coach for their diving program. TNYA is a masters aquatics program in New York City that provides a safe space for the LGBTQ+ community and their allies to engage in aquatics sports such as swimming, water polo, diving and synchronized swimming.

General requirements include experience working with USA Diving clubs, current membership as a competition coach with USA Diving, and successful completion of required USA Diving certification training courses (Deep Water Safety and Risk Management Training, Concussion Awareness Training Course, and U.S. Center for SafeSport Training). Candidate must be in good standing with USA Diving. Any candidates that are not certified USA Diving Competition Coaches but are interested in the position are welcome to apply as well. Candidates should also embrace TNYA's mission of providing a safe space in the water for LGBTQ+ community. Compensation will be commensurate with experience and qualifications.
